One issue that has become important to consumers is that of pests and diseases. People are being far more careful to ensure they do not buy plants infested with new pests like coqui frogs, nettle caterpillars and Little Fire Ants. For many nurseries, this is seen as a problem, but you can turn this into a marketing advantage!

At this free workshop, you will learn Little Fire Ant biology, treatment methods specific to the nursery setting, and trained staff will be available to answer your specific questions. You can also sign-up to be part of the “No Ants in my Plants” program. The “no ants” program is a free cooperative risk management scheme, implemented by Hawai‘i Ant Lab, USDA and Pacific Cooperative Studies Unit of the University of Hawaii.
